Modifications to the HEALTH BENEFITS PACKAGES

1. Revision and restructuring of the number of packages and procedures on account duplicity. Summary of the number is given below:

2. Addition of Packages: A total of 22 packages have been added. Highlight of this addition specialty wise is given as follows:

Note: Addition of these new packages is mainly to avoid blocking of unspecified package.

3. Removal of Packages:

- a) A total of 23 packages have been removed due to duplicity of packages between NHA and SNA packages. Two packages where SNA rate has been kept prior to removal of packages e.g. Distal Pancreatectomy.
- b) High-end Drugs: A total of 12 high end drugs has been removed from the HBP, owing to the duplicity of drugs name in the HBP.
- c) 10 Diagnostic Laboratory Packages have been removed.

4. Reduction of Package Rates:

- a. High-end Drugs: A total of 17 drugs where rates has been reduced.
- b. Per Day Rates: Per **day Rates** for District Hospital has been reduced to 10% from the existing packages rate. (General ward, HDU, ICU without ventilator and ICU with Ventilator).

6. Mapping of Packages for Cross Speciality:

A total of 41 packages has been mapped as Cross specialties, this will allow hospital and treating doctor to access to packages which are under the same package name, same procedure but under different specialties, hence avoiding unnecessary request for unspecified surgery or blocking of unspecified general ward package for conservative management of treatment.

7. OPD Diagnostic:

- Categorisation of OPD Diagnostic into radiological diagnostic, laboratory diagnostic and diagnostic.
- Utilisation of High end radiological diagnostic (CT, MRI, Imaging including nuclear imaging) for medical management at a rate whichever is lesser in comparison to Diagnostic-radiological packages.
